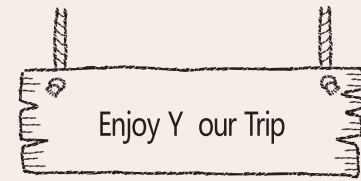




## Hon-machi/Higashi-machi Shopping Street

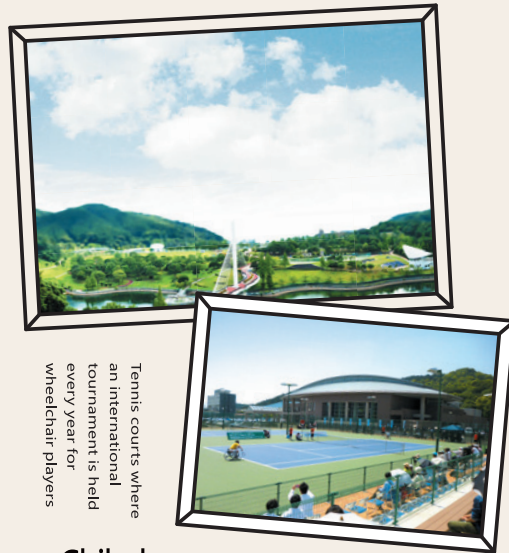

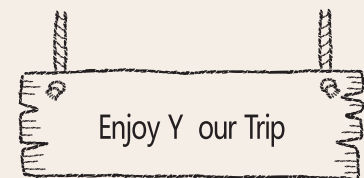

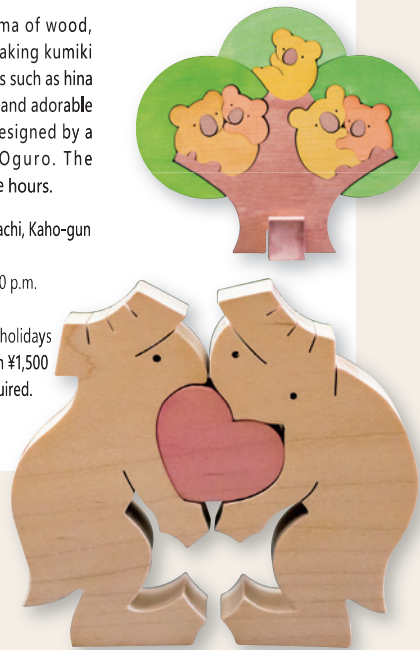
